- Alvarez – Translator.
- Katie Hong reviews the High Priority School Grant 2006-2007.
- Ms. Hong reviewed allocations line by line.
- Day to Day subs – money for teacher to attend training

- Office Supplies – paper, duplo ink is majority.
- Contracted Services – Inspiration 52.
- Conference fees, hotels, meals, etc... CLMS gets majority of funding.
- Training that are 30-40 miles away.
- Change for managing the grant: LACOE & LAUSD.
- Ms. Hong field questions regarding the High Priority School Grant.
- Allocation for intervention purpose ONLY in English Language Arts and Mathematics.
- Ms. Landers motions to accept the budget as presented, Mr. Aguilar seconds the motion.
- Accepted 12:18 P.M.
- Ms. Hong continues with Budget Adjustment Request – Rodriguez Consent Decree Allocation.
- Allocated \$7,140 – Day to Day Substitutes.
- Allocated \$35,420 – Professional Expert – teacher to work with new teachers.
- Allocated \$5,000 – Clerical-Overtime (maternity leave, etc...).
- Total: \$47,560.
